 Commissioner Orth moved and Commissioner Linsalata seconded to accept the Treasurer's report. The motion passed unanimously.
- 8. RECEIVE MONTHLY REPORT FROM THE TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 FIRE CHIEF REGARDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATIONS, RESPONSE TIMES, CALL VOLUME, TRAINING, MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES AND PERSONNEL;

Chief Perkins discussed EMS operations and difficulties with the City of Austin's call dispatch routing. He noted that sometimes call priorities change once EMS operators arrive on the scene.

Chief Perkins discussed the third class of 49 cadets and noted they are gaining strides in diversity. He discussed the 9/11 Staircase climb. He discussed the presentation of Allegiance at the City Council meeting, and noted a Council member confronted Allegiance about a patient's death and noted they expressed their concerns on the Allegiance agreement.

Commissioner Howe expressed his disdain for when Allegiance noted they had no comment when confronted about the patient's death.

9. RECEIVE MONTHLY REPORT FROM THE DISTRICT'S LEGAL COUNSEL REGARDING CONTRACT ISSUES, AND ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS TO INCLUDE THE CASE OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, ET AL. V. TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 17, ET. AL, AND CONSIDER TAKING ACTION AS MAY BE NECESSARY;

Mr. Katz shared reported the case will be taken up by the Court of Appeals on submission on Sept 21. The judge Court panel will consider the case based on the paperwork and written argument sent to the Court of Appeals, which could result in a ruling within a month.

Commissioner Howe asked if there could be at a resolution for this by the end of September. Mr. Katz replied that the ruling could affirm the order of dismissal of the trial court trial, or determine that the case is moot and/or issue an (advisory opinion) or the Court of Appeals could reverse the order of dismissal of the trial court and remand the case back to the trial court. There could be an update by the next meeting.
